Minutes of the Meeting of Ebberston with Yedingham Parish Council held in Ebberston Village Hall on 13/01/2020 commenced at 7pm

PRESENT: Cllrs L Allanson (Chair) S Walker J Wood, B Stockdale, A McLaughlin and Mrs L Myers the clerk.

Members of the Public: Ryedale District Councillor Will Oxley.

1. Welcome to all. Cllr Allanson was elected Chair for the meeting.
2. **Apologies Accepted:** Cllrs M Eyre, D Chambers and Cllr D Delaney (RDC)
3. **Co-option of New Councillor Andy McLaughlin, Declaration of Office signed.**
4. **Open Forum –** Ryedale District Council has refused the removal of the phone from the phone box in Yedingham.
5. **Declarations of Interest –** none.
6. **Minutes of the meeting** on Monday 11th November 2019 were agreed. Resolved.
7. **To Receive information on ongoing issues and decide further action**
 - 7.1 **Yedingham Allotments** – An allotment society has been formed with membership of the National Allotment Society. The site is to be cleared and a parking area formed. Over the next few months.
 - 7.2 **Land registry CL365 CL366 Sandsprunt Lane and Scarth Lane** – no new information.
 - 7.3 **Highways Issues** – The playground signs are damaged and the SLOW signs on the road need re doing – reported to highways, still no information from highways.
 - 7.4 **Tree liabilities and drainage** – A map of the trees has been completed. There is ivy to be removed from some trees. The safety of 4 trees to be investigated. The ditches down the Back Lane to be cleared. To write to all landowners concerned. 2 very small trees have been planted at the bottom of the village donated by tree for free campaign.
 - 7.5 **Sports Field Association** – A discussion took place around insurance, grants and new equipment. Several Parish councillors to attend the playground committee to offer support. To look into co-ordination equipment purchase and insurance across local play parks.
 - 7.6 **Vehicle Activated speed signs** – further information given by Cllr. W Oxley. The cost of the speed sign is about £3,000 which would be shared across 3 Parishes. Consideration of a camera to be added to help with safety. A meeting may be held between representatives of the Councils. The infrastructure cost is about £1,000 which may be covered by a grant from Cllr. Sanderson NYCC. More discussion required to consolidate this proposal.
 - 7.7 **Dog Waste Bin Mill Lane** – in situ.
 - 7.8 **Post Office Van Ebberston** - .This has been requested and waiting for a response.
8. **PLANNING Applications received**
 - 8.1 NYM/2018/0653/FL St. Athanasius Monastery, Langdale End, Construction of a Church with vehicular access and landscaping. Brought to the attention of the Parish Council by a resident of Bickley. Considering the Plans the Parish Council felt the architecture of the building was out of character for the rural area and the road access is not suitable for the amount of traffic proposed.
