Upcoming internal audit of parish council accounts discussed – proposed James Ingham be appointed as internal auditor and subsequently resolved.

- 5.1 Cllr Langham to investigate the possibility of obtaining an arboricultural report in relation to the trees in question. If trees were to be removed a felling licence would be required
- 5.2 Vehicle Activated Speed sign appears to be having a positive effect on speeding through the village
- 5.3 Parish Clerk to follow up on communication between the Post Office and Ebberston chapel regarding possible post office services in the village
- 5.4 Chairman received an information sheet from Ebberston Tidy Group (Lynne Hall) relating to a list of tasks which could be undertaken in the village by the proposed volunteer group. Chairman to liaise with Lynne Hall
- 5.5 Highways to be contacted by Parish Clerk regarding the drains/soak aways on A170 which appear to be blocked and contributing to the flooding in the village

It was proposed the ditches in the village be cleared by the proposed volunteer group

Cllr Wood reported a blocked pipe on the Yedingham road resulting in water not flowing to the fields. Clerk to contact the highways department to ask them to clear it.

A second estimate to be obtained in relation to the work required to improve the beck and to prevent silt travelling down stream. Cllr Oxley advised grants may be available to help with the cost
