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Minutes of the Meeting of Ebberston with Yedingham Parish Council held in Ebberston Village Hall on Monday 26th September 2022 commenced at 7pm

1. **Apologies Accepted:** Cllrs M Eyre, A Ross
2. **Open Forum** – Potential use of land at Yedingham currently partially used as allotments. Alternative uses suggested – community housing scheme, woodland cemetery. Cllr Langford believed the site could be of historical importance and this may prove difficult. It was suggested that all property belonging to the parish council be checked that it is registered as such with Land Registry.
3. **Declarations of Interest** – N/A
4. **Minutes of the meeting** on Monday 11th July 2022 - Resolved.
5. **To Receive information on ongoing issues and decide further action**
 - 5.1 Cllr Langford in negotiations with highways regarding installation of gateways. Grant monies are available toward the cost which will also include new signage. Speed Gun to be donated to Yedingham by Allerston Parish Council as they are obtaining a new one.
 - 5.2 Contractor to return to complete outstanding work on beck de-silting. Cllr McLaughlin questioned whether the contractor had carried out the amount of de-silting originally agreed. Cllr Langford confirmed the contractor would not be carrying out any further work other than what has already been agreed.
 - 5.3 Following a meeting with Kate Yates-Yorkshire Wildlife Trust regarding the silt traps and maintenance agreement Yorkshire Wildlife Trust have requested, it was agreed that the silt traps would be monitored by both parties until March 2023 when the situation would be reviewed. Yorkshire Wildlife Trust are to clear the grips which have been filled in by the contractor who carried out the tree felling when he returns in the autumn. They have also offered to make bales from forest vegetation to assist the maintenance of the beck.
 - 5.4 To obtain quotes to carry out the maintenance/repairs to the bus shelter.
