2. **Open Forum** – Cllr Walker raised the issue of stones being removed from the beck outside 4 Main Street, Ebberston

- 5.1 Awaiting decision on Rural Community Grant Application for the purchase of the gateways at Yedingham
- 5.2 Letter has been sent to the contractor regarding the remaining beck maintenance work to be carried out but to date no response has been received.
- 5.3 Highways have confirmed they are to install chevron signs on the bend and a white edge of carriageway line to further highlight the curvature of the road. North Yorkshire Police have advised they do not feel it necessary to carry out a speed review. Cllr McLaughlin very disappointed with the response received from parties involved and that the joint meeting requested between highways, police, parish council and residents of Yedingham has not been possible.
- 5.4 Awaiting decision on Rural Community Grant Application to carry out the maintenance/repairs to the bus shelter/notice boards.
- 5.5 Still awaiting the gullies to be cleared by Highways. Clerk to contact Highways regarding the urgency of dealing with the gully outside 118 Main St.
- 5.6 Further Rural Community Grant Application to be submitted to purchase 2 benches one for Yedingham and Ebberston.

6. **PLANNING Applications received** – 202228 South Moor Farm Woodland

Creation Project (North York Moors) - The point of woodland creation is to link existing woodlands together referred to as a "woodland corridor" so we would expect complete coverage. On the plan submitted there is a strip of land left uncovered and we would question why? In our opinion the whole area should be covered with woodland and no gaps in the middle.
